• FY 2019 CDBG – Glenolden Park Walking Path – Phase 2

We received Application for Payment No. 2 (Final) in the amount of \$17,135.00 submitted by A to U Services, Inc. and upon processing we will present to the Borough Manager for signature.

- **Academy Ave. Repaving**
We received the canceled check for payment to Ridley Township and are finalizing the completion report.
- **Former Glenolden Swim Club**
The applicant's engineer advised:
 - Regarding the submission of plans for recording, they received the signed plans from the Owner and submitted to the Borough for signatures.
 - They are still addressing comments from PennDOT for the Highway Occupancy permit.
- **MacDade Signal Project**
PennDOT advised:
 - Department 180-day testing period is still in progress on all signals.
 - ADA ramps have been reviewed by PennDOT and results have been sent to the contractor for corrections. No date yet on when the subcontractor is going to make the corrections.
 - Completion of punch-list items from the walk through inspections from November 15th- 17th is still ongoing. PennDOT will have a subcontractor going to the site Friday 1/21/2022 to complete most of the punch list items.
- **FY 2021 CDBG MacDade Boulevard Improvements**
We are finalizing draft design plans needed for the PennDOT Highway Occupancy and will submit to PennDOT by the end of this week.
- **South Ave. Bridge**
The Borough Manager has also obtained 1926 Borough Ordinances approving the installation of the sanitary sewer system on South Ave. I will forward info to the County consultant.
- **Glenolden – R - 119 Grays Ave**
Construction is in progress.
- **Chapter 94 Report**
We are commencing the report due February 18, 2022. We requested that the Borough Secretary forward the 2021 Aqua Water Usage report to us upon receipt.
