We met with Mike Puppio and provided a packet of information for him to prepare correspondence to both CSX attorneys and the PUC to express the urgency of obtaining approvals. We have received a positive review of the draft RFP for a construction inspector. We have continued to attempt to obtain the utility agreement with PECO without any success to date. A letter was sent to AECOM requesting that the Borough be able to pay CSX fees as invoiced during the project on April 29, 2010, and we are awaiting a reply. A mock-up of the proposed project sign was sent to Sign-O-Rama to get their input on materials and specifications to include in the project bid package.
