MAYOR BATHURST – We had a relatively quiet season and the police were not actively engaged in anything of a serious nature. Everything is going smoothly down stairs. I think everyone is healthy at this point, except for Officer Illich. The mall was used by the Dreamworks film company, filming a movie based on the book, The Lovely Bones, and we were able as they were tearing down the set, they took the entire Glenolden end of the mall and made it look like a mall of the 1970's. They put the

little counter restaurant back that was there and when they were taking things apart they were kind enough to allow us to have some props from the movie, which we can stick in the display case out here. When you see the movie and you see the mall scene, there were 140 extras and most of them were carrying these big shopping bags. There's also bags from the bookstore that they were able to leave us have and they also gave us a menu from 1970 with the actual 1970 prices, which we can use. If you wanted a fresh cut of pie it was twenty cents, club sandwich sixty-five cents, and you can see how things have changed. I believe the movie comes out in 2009 and if I'm correct Chief there were really no incidents with all the filming and such that were being done up there.

Chief Donahue – The only incident we had was after hours where they had a couple cable thefts, where they left the cable outside and someone helped themselves to it. But there were no problems with the movie shoot or in the mall.

President Danzi – Next week. I would ask you to keep this in mind four years ago they didn't even have a website.

Mrs. Boland – I went to the Library you see, but I'm getting old now and if I can stay home and do it, I'd rather do that.

President Danzi – Okay, we're going to make sure you get to do that.

Mrs. Boland – Alright, I'll hold you to it, I have your number. Now could you tell me this, who is the Health officer now?

President Danzi – The Health officer is still Phyllis Duffy, but she told us her desire to retire, so she is going to stay on and we put Kris McCray, who is a registered nurse, lives up on Sharp Avenue, who is finalizing classes and whatever she needs to do and Phyllis will work with her until she's ready to take over.

Mrs. Boland – Well, I thought I heard a second name at the Re-Organization meeting and I didn't hear anything else. What will this cost now?

Mr. Hoover – Same as it did before. No change in cost.

President Danzi – To the Borough you mean?

Mrs. Boland – Yeah.

Mr. Hoover – It's the same, there is no change in cost right now, it'll continue to be

Mrs. Boland – I wouldn't have to ask you if I'd seen the budget.

President Danzi – Okay Mrs. Boland, thank you for your input.

Mrs. Boland – You don't really mean that.

President Danzi – I do. Okay, anyone else tonight? Could be a record meeting. We are going to have an executive meeting, still wrapping up some personnel issues. As soon as Mike Puppio gets here, he'll handle some of that.
