Glenolden Park Project

The additional funding request was submitted to OHCD and we are awaiting County Council's decision. The contracts have been submitted to Borough Manager for execution. We requested and received some missing contract documents from A to U Services. Once OHCD gets the Contract copy they will schedule a pre-construction meeting. By that time we should have nailed down what will be removed from the contract.

Bridge Inspections

Regarding the results of PENNDOT's inspections of Academy Ave & Hibbs Ave bridges we need to address repair items.

FY 2017 - CDBG

We have been notified the Park Pathway application has been selected for funding in the amount of \$144,018. County Council is accepting public comment until May 1, 2017.

Would like to inform us that Delaware County will be undergoing a Countywide Reassessment. The last reassessment was done 17 years ago based on the assessment of 1998 which was 19 years ago. The county has purchased the software to begin the process. He will keep us updated on the progress and when the reassessment should begin.
