Sewer Project at Mukinipatis Creek on MacDade

We requested that PennDOT provide an a formal list of concerns related to use of the CDBG funds as well as the schedule. We believe there may be a way to resolve the issues. We are awaiting their response.

Mulford Bridge Repairs

We were approached by the County's consultant regarding the possibility of them repairing the storm sewer crossing Glenolden Avenue due to some savings they realized in the project. It was determined there was not enough saved to perform the repair.

MS4

Several months ago it was suggested that I attend a workshop to provide more information on the requirements of the next round of permit (2018). We also have the requirement for an annual public meeting to describe the program and current status. Once a date is selected it would need to be advertised on the website and in the Prime (if possible). We completed additional outfall screening on March 31.

If anyone is interested in getting involved an upcoming event promoted by the Chester Ridley Crum Watershed Association is being held Saturday, April 30, 2016 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM – 19th Annual CRC Streams Cleanup. Registration information can be found on their website www.crcwatersheds.org.

Road Programs

Gardner Ave. – We are awaiting the contracts to be returned from INNCON and upon receipt will forward to the Borough for execution, obtain PennDOT approval and issue the notice to proceed.

Harrison Avenue – We coordinated with the Borough Manager for the bids due May 16 at 10:00 AM. We are preparing the bid documents.

FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant

We forwarded a Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA) circular that provides guidance for the applications due to PEMA May 18, 2016. We are requesting that the Borough review and advise if they have a project they want to pursue.

FY 2016 CDBG

The OHCD issued the Action Plan and the Parks Improvements project was not selected. The public comment period is to May 2, 2016.
