On June 27, we attended the Eastern Delaware County Stormwater Collaborative (EDCSWC) meeting at Yeadon Borough regarding the Pollution Reduction Plan. Modifications to the PRP Agreement were discussed as well as potential projects. To support their efforts, we prepared the Storm Sewershed Map including proposed

improvements and forwarded to the EDCSWC. We are working with the Collaborative in order to supply information necessary for the Plan preparation. I will have more results in present at the August Council meeting. We need to coordinate the remaining screening of outfalls. Require access to University of Penn property.

PennDOT Highway Performance Monitoring System

We are preparing data for the requested roadways based on information from previous road programs and will forward to the Borough Manager when complete. Due to PennDOT October 1, 2017.

AQUA Projects – S. Ridgeway

Aqua offered a contribution of \$59,000.00 for the trenches and mill and overlay of one-half width road and \$25,000.00 for the mill and overlay only. We recommend that the Borough does not accept this offer.

Sewer Issues MacDade and South

We met with the Borough Manager and Cleaver Cable at the site on July 11. We recommended that the storm manhole with a plate over and the nearby system is cleaned and televised. We recommended that the Borough Manager contact Luke Oil regarding the blockage in the culvert along their property.

Glenolden Park Walking Path Project

We attended the kick-off meeting at the OHCD office on July 12. We will coordinate the field survey with the Borough Manager.
