**Aqua Project/Road Program**

The main replacement is complete on Elmwood Avenue. Services will be started at the end of May and are expected to take approximately 3 weeks. They have made an offer of \$70,000 for restoration. We will complete our evaluation of the contribution in lieu of once services are complete.

**Royal Farms**

Revised plans were submitted yesterday. I have had several conversations with Mark Damico regarding their alternatives to getting the sewage planning exemption acknowledged by PADEP and a temporary highway occupancy permit, to begin construction. They have been informed their (HOP) will not be issued until late June or early July.

**Flood Plain Ordinance**

I am in the process of working with a representative of the PA Department of Community and Economic Development.

**MS4 Program**

The Borough Manager and I attended a workshop concerning the upcoming changes to the MS4 Permit. The Borough will be required to prepare a Pollution Reduction Plan, mostly for sediments, when the next permit cycle comes around. The Notice of Intent (NOI) is due September 2017. There are a number of requirements, and the group is encouraged to work together with other groups (CRC, Eastern SW Collaborative) to get more accomplished for less. It was decided to further discuss at a future Workshop Meeting.
