Mayor Quinn - Dear Chief Kelly, Please accept the appreciation of the Norwood Police Dept. for the assistance you and your officers provided during the early morning hours of Sunday, August 30th at the Mohawk Manor Apartments in Norwood Borough. Our department responded there for a suicidal subject. Shortly thereafter, Officer Hanly of the Ridley Park Police Department, who was also providing us with assistance, was shot twice by the subject at point blank range with a .45 caliber handgun. With an incident of this magnitude, our department exceeded our resources. You provided Norwood Borough man power for both the incident and call coverage. I appreciate you and your officers' response to our call for assistance and providing vital services to our department. Thankfully, because he was wearing his bulletproof vest, Officer Hanly survived. Our prayers and best wishes are with Officer Hanly during his recuperation. I would like to take this opportunity to express my sincere appreciation and thank you and all your officers that responded. Sincerely, Mark DelVecchio, Chief of Police, Norwood Police. This letter is an attestation to the quality of our Police department with Chief Kelly, Sgt. Gensemer, and this Council has strived to have the best Officers and I think right now we have a fine Police department. I want to congratulate Chief Kelly with his men. And as always, I tell everybody if they see anything out of the ordinary to call 9-1-1 and our Police will respond no matter how little the call is they will respond to the call to check it out. Please don't hesitate to call. And that's all I have.
