We have received the contracts back from A. F. Damon for signature. We are also in the process of reviewing the pavement mix design and preparing the application for approval from PennDOT Municipal Services.

FEMA

We have responded to the request from FEMA for a review of the updated mapping. We have forwarded the Borough's Ordinance for FEMA's review. The changes to the mapping do not directly impact the Borough, but because of the changes from the Delaware River and Darby Creek, which are contained in the panel that also covers the Borough, you will need to update the Flood Plain Ordinance to revise the date of the map. This is also an opportunity for the Borough to correct and issue with the current mapping.
