We have drafted the Completion Report for the first program and are processing contracts for the Benson Avenue project.

MS4 Program

1st Year Report for the renewal permit was submitted August 29, 2014. We have a positive result for Outfall 4300 and have contacted Damon Engineers regarding any potential overflows of the Muckinipates Interceptor. The Borough Manager and I attended a presentation for the CRC Watershed Association regarding stream health in the area. The conclusion of the meeting was that the Borough may be subjected to requirements to improve impaired streams in the next permit renewal in four years.

Royal Farms

Bohler Engineers have reached out regarding process for sewer connection and planning information that we are in the process of responding to.
